

## Notice to Families of Students Who Did Not Participate in or Complete Summative Testing in Spring 2020

Dear Parent, Guardian, or Adult Student:

Oregon schools transitioned to Distance Learning for All in April 2020 due to factors related to the COVID-19 pandemic and extended school closures. With the transition to distance learning, the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) worked with the United States Department of Education to waive statewide assessment requirements for the 2019-2020 school year.

All students in grades 3-8 and grade 11 were not able to complete the following statewide assessment(s) prior to transitioning to distance learning:

- English Language Arts (ELA)
- Mathematics
- Science

Though reporting results from statewide summative assessments from 2019-20 is not required, Harney UH1J and Harney 4 will provide you with a copy of your child's scores for any assessments that they did complete for informational purposes only.

Your child will not need to make up ELA, Mathematics, or Science summative assessments that were scheduled for spring 2020. If your student was scheduled to take the ELPA Summative, but did not have the opportunity to complete it due to the transition to distance learning, Ms. Anne Sheeter will contact you with more information.
